

The Future of the U.S.–Israel Special Relationship

Israel's wars with Hamas, Hezbollah and Iran mark, in many ways, a high-water mark in U.S.–Israel strategic cooperation. But polling data and the explosive growth of attacks (verbal and physical) on Jews raise alarms about the future of the American Jewish community and the relationship with Israel. What might the future hold, and what can we do about it?
