# ESSENTIAL QUESTION(S)

• How can celebration bring us closer to Judaism and Israel?

## **OBJECTIVES:**

## Students will:

• Be able to compare & contrast the celebration of *Yom Ha'atzmaut* in Israel and Independence Day in USA.

## **ASSESSMENT:**

The students will plan and execute a Yorn Ha'atzmaut celebration for the class or the school

## **MATERIALS, SUPPLIES AND RESOURCES**
