LETTER DATED 28 MAY 1980 FROM THE ACTING PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF PAKISTAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

In my capacity as the Representative of Pakistan, the current Chairman of the Organization of the Islamic Conference, I have the honour to draw your attention to the decision taken by the Eleventh Islamic Conference of Foreign Ministers, held in Islamabad from 17 to 21 May 1980, calling for an immediate meeting of the Security Council to examine the dangerous situation arising from the latest decision by the Israeli authorities seeking to annex and declare Al Quds Al Sharif (the Holy City of Jerusalem) as the capital of Israel.

In accordance with the decision of the Eleventh Islamic Conference of Foreign Ministers, I have the honour to request you, on behalf of the members of the Islamic Conference, to convene an immediate meeting of the Security Council to consider the serious and dangerous implications of the above-mentioned Israeli moves and their consequences on the endeavours for achieving a comprehensive, just and lasting peace in the Middle East, in accordance with the relevant resolutions of the United Nations.
